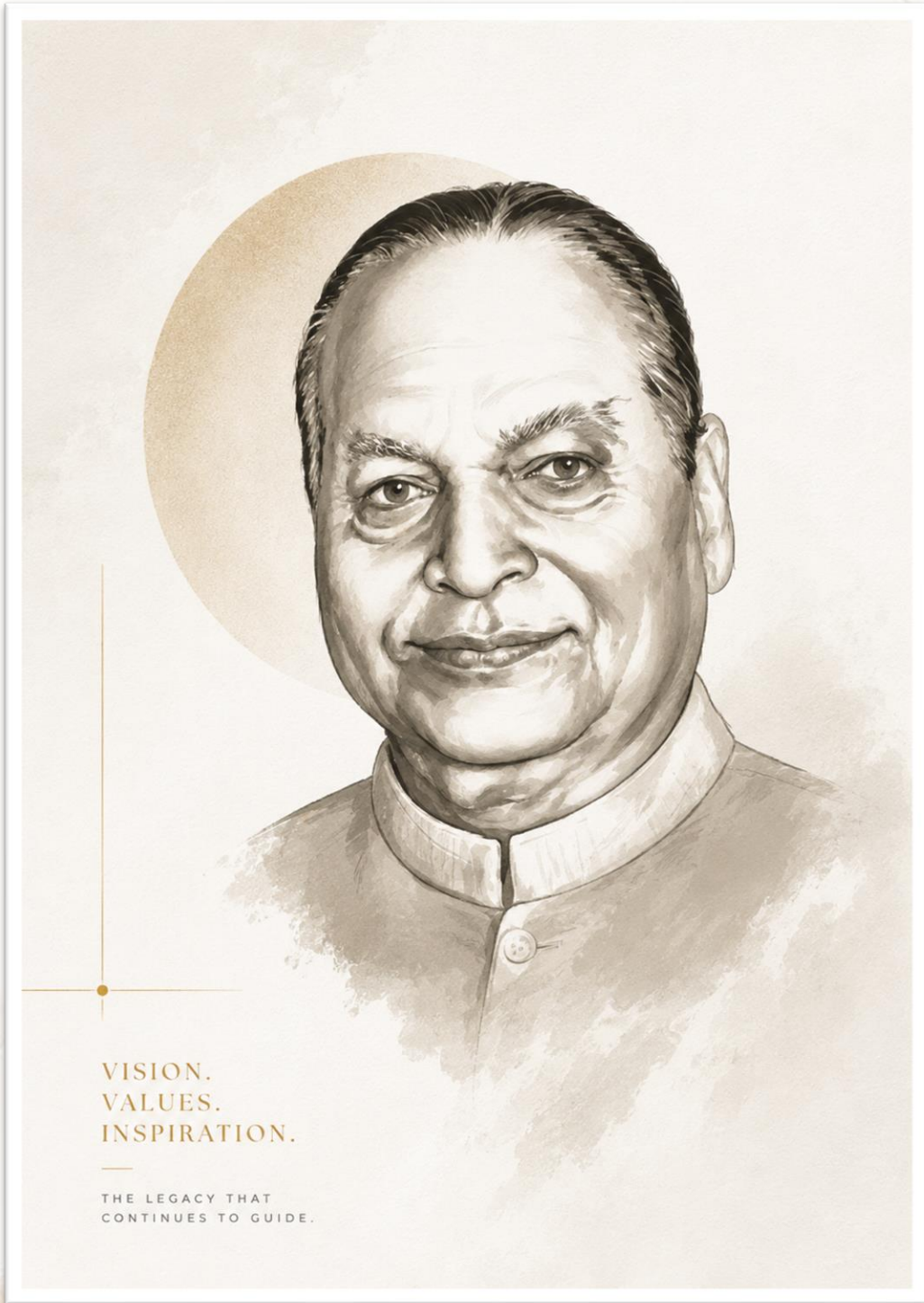

COLLEGE AT A GLANCE

Amolakchand Mahavidyalaya, Yavatmal, was established by Vidya Prasarak Mandal in 1956. The Mandal is registered under Act No. XXI of 1860 (Regd. No. F-27/YTL/122-55-56). The objectives of the society are as given below:

- To impart and promote education in Literature, Science, Arts, Commerce, Law, Technology, and the diffusion of cultural and useful knowledge.
- To start, conduct, and take over schools, colleges, and other institutions for imparting moral, physical, cultural, literary, scientific, technical, vocational, and professional education.
- To undertake and facilitate research in all branches of knowledge.
- To carry out experiments with a view to improving methods of imparting instructions to youth and adults, with the objective of making them better citizens of the world.
- To co-operate with approved institutions for the purpose of supporting the above objectives and to adopt such other measures as may appear desirable for achieving them.

ABOUT THE COLLEGE:

The college was established by the society in 1956 to fulfill the aforementioned objectives. It initially began in the 'Mor Bhavan' of the town with 40 students during the academic session 1956–57. At that time, the college was affiliated with Nagpur University, Nagpur.

Today, the college has a well-established infrastructure, including buildings, laboratories, a library, an auditorium, gardens, playgrounds for boys

and girls, smart digital boards, etc., spread across 39 acres of land. The college offers education at the Higher Secondary level, undergraduate programs in Humanities, Commerce & Management, Home Science, and Science & Technology, as well as postgraduate programs in Humanities (Economics, History, Political Science, English, Marathi, and Hindi), Commerce, and Science (Chemistry, Mathematics, Physics, Botany, Zoology, Computer Science, and Electronics). Since 1983, the college has been affiliated with Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Amravati.

The foundation stone of the college was laid on 1st February 1958 by Shri Yashwantraoji Chavan, the then Chief Minister of Mumbai State. The college was honored by the visit of Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru, the first Prime Minister of India, who inaugurated the Science Faculty on 18th April 1959. It is a matter of pride that the foundation stone of the building was laid by such eminent leaders.

Today, the college holds a prestigious position not only in the Vidarbha region but also across Maharashtra. The Golden Jubilee of the college was celebrated with the gracious blessings of His Excellency Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam, Honorable President of India. His Excellency Shri Bhaironsingh Shekhawat, Honorable Vice-President of India, and Her Excellency Smt. Pratibha Patil, Honorable President of India, have also visited the college.

Over time, the college has expanded its academic offerings with a conscious focus on the employability of its courses. Many of its students have achieved distinction in various fields. The management of the college is making every possible effort to meet the challenges of the ever-expanding world of knowledge and to empower students to lead lives enriched both materially and spiritually.

महाविद्यालय एका दृष्टीक्षेपात

अमोलकचंद महाविद्यालय, यवतमाळची स्थापना सन 1956 मध्ये विद्या प्रसारक मंडळ, यवतमाळ द्वारा करण्यात आली. विद्या प्रसारक मंडळाची नोंदणी धर्मदाय कायदा 1860 च्या अधिनियम क्रमांक XXI (REGD. NO. F-27/YTL/122-55-56) अंतर्गत करण्यात आली आहे. संस्थेची उद्दिष्टे खालीलप्रमाणे आहेत:

- साहित्य, विज्ञान, कला, वाणिज्य, तंत्रज्ञान व सांस्कृतिक तसेच उपयुक्त ज्ञानाचा प्रसार आणि प्रचार करणे.
- नैतिक, भौतिक, सांस्कृतिक, साहित्यिक, वैज्ञानिक, तांत्रिक आणि व्यावसायिक शिक्षणाच्या संधी उपलब्ध करून देण्यासाठी नवीन महाविद्यालये सुरू करणे, तसेच विद्यमान शाळा, महाविद्यालये आणि इतर संस्था चालविणे वा ताब्यात घेणे.
- ज्ञान व विज्ञानाच्या सर्व शाखांमध्ये संशोधन आणि सुलभीकरण करणे.
- तरुण व विद्यार्थ्यांना उत्तम नागरिक बनविण्याच्या उद्देशाने मार्गदर्शक सूचनांमध्ये सुधारणा करण्याच्या दृष्टीने प्रयोग व प्रयत्न करणे.
- वरील उद्दिष्टे पूर्ण करण्यासाठी उपयुक्त अशा इतर उपाययोजना राबविणे व अन्य मान्यताप्राप्त संस्थांशी सहकार्य करणे.

वरील उद्दिष्टांची पूर्तता करण्यासाठी संस्थेने सन १९५६ मध्ये महाविद्यालयाची स्थापना केली. शैक्षणिक सत्र १९५६-५७ मध्ये केवळ ४० विद्यार्थ्यांपासून मोर भवन या शहरातील इमारतीत महाविद्यालय सुरू करण्यात आले. शैक्षणिक सत्र १९८२-८३ पर्यंत हे महाविद्यालय नागपूर विद्यापीठाशी संलग्नित होते, तर सत्र १९८३-८४ पासून संत गाडगेबाबा अमरावती विद्यापीठाशी संलग्न आहे.

सद्यस्थितीत महाविद्यालयाचा परिसर ३९ एकरांवर पसरलेला असून, प्रशस्त इमारती, सुसज्ज प्रयोगशाळा, ७०,००० हून अधिक पुस्तके असलेले समृद्ध ग्रंथालय, भव्य सभागृह, जिमखाना तसेच विविध खेळांचे मैदान व इतर सुविधा उपलब्ध आहेत. महाविद्यालयात राष्ट्रीय छात्र सेना (NCC), राष्ट्रीय सेवा योजना (NSS) आणि विविध शैक्षणिक व अभ्यासेतर उपक्रम प्रभावीपणे राबविले जातात.

महाविद्यालयात ११वी व १२वी कला, वाणिज्य, विज्ञान आणि कौशल्याधिष्ठित व्यावसायिक अभ्यासक्रम तसेच मानवविद्या, विज्ञान व तंत्रज्ञान, वाणिज्य व व्यवस्थापन शाखांतून पदवी अभ्यासक्रम उपलब्ध आहेत. वाणिज्य, अर्थशास्त्र, राज्यशास्त्र, इतिहास, मराठी, इंग्रजी, हिंदी, रसायनशास्त्र, गणित, भौतिकशास्त्र, जीवशास्त्र, वनस्पतीशास्त्र, संगणकशास्त्र, विद्युतप्रमाणण शास्त्र इत्यादी विषयांत पदव्युत्तर शिक्षणाची सुविधाही येथे उपलब्ध आहे.

महाविद्यालयाच्या मुख्य इमारतीचे भूमिपूजन १ फेब्रुवारी १९७८ रोजी मुंबई राज्याचे तत्कालीन मुख्यमंत्री श्री यशवंतराव चव्हाण यांच्या हस्ते झाले, तर १८ एप्रिल १९७९ रोजी भारताचे पहिले पंतप्रधान पंडित जवाहरलाल नेहरू यांच्या शुभहस्ते विज्ञान शाखेचे उद्घाटन करण्यात आले. या दोन्ही थोर व्यक्तींच्या उपस्थितीत झालेली पायाभरणी ही महाविद्यालयासाठी अत्यंत गौरवाची बाब आहे.

महामहीम राष्ट्रपती डॉ. ए. पी. जे. अब्दुल कलाम यांच्या शुभाशीर्वादाने महाविद्यालयाचा सुवर्ण महोत्सव साजरा करण्यात आला. तसेच महामहीम राष्ट्रपती श्रीमती प्रतिभाताई पाटील यांच्या हस्ते सुवर्ण महोत्सव समारोपाचा कार्यक्रम संपन्न झाला. याच कालावधीत महामहीम उपराष्ट्रपती श्री भैरोंसिंह शेखावत यांची महाविद्यालयाला दिलेली भेट गौरवाची ठरली. त्यामुळे महाविद्यालयाला केवळ विदर्भातच नव्हे तर संपूर्ण महाराष्ट्रात मानाचे स्थान प्राप्त झाले आहे.

COLLEGE INFRASTRUTURE

MAIN BUILDING:

The main building of the College consists of classrooms, laboratories, a library, and the administrative block. The ground floor of the College and the auditorium were constructed during 1958–1962. The foundation stone of the main building was laid by Shri Yashwantraoji Chavan, Chief Minister of Bombay State, on 1 February 1958. The College was blessed by Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru, the first Prime Minister of India, who inaugurated the Science Faculty of the College on 18 April 1958. The ground floor, covering 3,375 square meters, and the auditorium, covering 1,203.84 square meters, were constructed in a single-phase using stone.

The first floor of the College comprises classrooms, the library, and a reading room, covering 3,325 square meters. It was constructed with grants received from the UGC during the 8th and 9th Plan periods. The College also has a women's hostel building of 200 square meters and six staff quarters covering 1,000 square meters. Additionally, the College has a workshop and classrooms spread over 880 square meters in the annexed MCVC building.

The MCVC building was inaugurated on 20 July 1995 by the Honorable Shri Madhavrao Scindia, then HRD Minister, Government of India. The classrooms in this building are used to conduct PG classes.

COLLEGE LIBRARY:

The College Library covers an area of 3900sq.ft. (369.2 sq.m.) and houses a large number of reference resources, books, journals, and periodicals. The main library of the College includes a reading room facility. The status of the library at the end of the academic session 2021–22 is as stated below:

Besides the main library, every department in the college has a departmental library, which is maintained by the heads of the respective departments. The college is a user of the N-LIST programme of INFLIBNET, funded by the UGC, as a college component under the UGC-INFONET Digital Library Consortium. It provides access to more than 6,000 e-journals (with archives of over 10 years) and more than 100,000 e-books.

The staff and students of the college avail themselves of this facility in the college library and at the Computer Centre in the Departments of Computer Science and Commerce. The resources are accessible at: <http://nlist.inflibnet.ac.in>.

AUDITORIUM:

The college has an auditorium spread over an area of 1,203.84 square meters, with a seating capacity of 600. It was constructed in 1962 by Vidya Prasarak Mandal. In addition to the auditorium, the auditorium building has three small and three large classrooms, open space, and rooms for the MPSC/UPSC/SSC/ Banking & all other competitive examination Guidance Centre, NCC Unit, Department of Music, and Department of Physical Education (Sports). A record room is located on the first floor. The auditorium is named after Shri. Vasant Rao Naik, the then Chief Minister of Maharashtra. It has hosted several cultural, literary, and educational events such as:

- The Silver and Golden Jubilee celebrations of the institution
- Numerous public debates, cultural programs, NSS and NCC state-level camps

These events have contributed significantly to the intellectual and cultural development of the college.

THE COLLEGE GARDEN:

The beautiful college campus, with its magnificent ambiance, is spread over 39 acres. The campus soil is reddish, rugged, and rocky, with low fertility. The premises also face a water shortage. Despite these challenges, the college began developing gardens on three separate plots following the first NAAC peer team visit:

- Sant Gadge Baba Fruit Garden – 1,181.73 sq. meters
- Jawaharlal Nehru Garden – 1,989.43 sq. meters (with equal areas for fruit and medicinal plants)
- Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Garden – 6,689.01 sq. meters

Drip irrigation systems with sprinklers have been installed, the depths of two wells have been increased, and submersible pumps have been added to help alleviate the water shortage. The total garden area is now 106,134 sq. ft. (9,860.17 sq. meters), developed through the efforts of Dr. S.S. Jadhav (Head, Department of Botany) and students. Plants from 128 families are represented, including:

- 1) 19 varieties of fruit plants
- 2) 21 varieties of medicinal plants
- 3) 21 varieties of forest and shade plants
- 4) 50 varieties of flowering and ornamental plants
- 5) 5 varieties of gymnosperms
- 6) 7 varieties of hydrophytes, and
- 7) 5 varieties of cacti.

The garden also features rare hydrophytes such as *Nymphaea* species (red, yellow, and blue), *Eichhornia*, *Pistia*, and *Salvinia*, collected from various regions.

GYMKHANA AND SPORTS:

The college gymkhana was established in 1986. The gymnasium is well-equipped with equipment such as treadmills, dumbbells, weightlifting sets, chest and arm expander benches, and stationary cycles. It is open to students and staff in two shifts; morning (7:00 AM to 9:00 AM) and evening (5:00 PM to 7:00 PM), on all working days, and free of charge.

The college has two large playgrounds that accommodate outdoor sports such as, Cricket, Hockey, Football, Volley Ball, Soft Ball, Basketball, Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Running Track, Shot Put, Javelin Throw, Long Jump Pit

etc. One of these playgrounds is reserved exclusively for girl students. The facilities for indoor games such as, Table Tennis, Lawn Tennis, Badminton, Chess, Carom etc. is available in auditorium. The College participates approximately in 12 sports events annually at various levels. A Sports and Gymkhana Committee manages all related matters. Student participation and achievements at national and international levels have become a regular feature of the institution.

CULTURAL ACTIVITIES:

The college actively encourages students to participate in various cultural activities. It supports student participation in inter-collegiate, district, and inter-university events such as: Yuva Mahotsav, Freshers' Party, Farewell Functions, and Alumni Meets. Students participate in events such as poetry

conventions, dancing, singing, drama, one-act plays, mime, traditional dress competitions, quiz contests, and debates. Over 50 students participate in the Yuva Mahotsav each year. The Cultural Committee oversees all cultural activities and events.

THE RESIDENTIAL QUARTERS

The college has six residential quarters for teaching staff and five for non-teaching staff.

THE HOSTEL:

The College is unique in the district which offers Higher Education in Humanities, Commerce, Science and Law. As a result, many students from rural areas seek admission.

Recognizing this need, the governing body-initiated hostel facilities for both boys and girls, which operated with full amenities until 1986. However, due to changing circumstances, because of establishment of new colleges in the city, Government hostels (by the Social Welfare Department) with all facilities, and availability of private hostels in the city, the demand for college hostels declined.

The college management decided to discontinue its hostel facility and have resolved to restart it if demand resurfaces. Currently, most students stay in government or private hostels.

NOTE: If any student wishes to seek hostel accommodation, they are advised to contact the Principal within 15 days of admission. The management is ready to resume hostel facilities on a no-loss, no-profit basis, if needed.

RESEARCH (Ph. D) CENTRE:

The Physics, Electronics, Chemistry, Zoology, and Computer Science laboratories are recognized as research centers by Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University. In addition, the college is recognized as a research center for the subjects of Economics, Marathi, English, and Commerce. A total of thirty (30) researchers has successfully completed their research in the last eight years.

DISCIPLINE AND CODE OF CONDUCT

GENERAL

- Students shall always carry their Identity Cards and produce them whenever demanded by teachers or other staff members of the college.
- Any tampering with or disfiguring of the Identity Card will be viewed seriously.
- Students shall obey the rules framed by the Principal for the smooth functioning of the institution.
- Students shall not bring outsiders to the college.
- Students shall leave the campus as soon as their classes are over for the day.
- A duplicate Identity Card will be issued only after payment of Rs. 100/- at the fee receipt counter.
- Students are instructed to remit all fees before the last date given. Failing this, they will be removed from the college rolls on the next working day without further notice.
- Students who take part in or organize any political activity or gatherings inside the college campus shall be considered to have committed serious indiscipline. Every member of such a gathering shall be dealt with individually and rigorously for indiscipline and misconduct. The Principal shall have the authority to take disciplinary action against students involved in such uncalled-for activities.
- Students shall not engage in or abet any political activity within the campus. Political activities and unnecessary political involvement are strictly banned on campus.
- It shall constitute gross indiscipline if students call for an appeal to strike based on policies and ideologies that may be preached by the political parties or their student organizations or student wings. The participants in the strike as aforesaid shall be dealt with the disciplinary authority and they shall be imposed appropriate punishment as provided in the rules.
- It shall be considered gross indiscipline if students call for or participate in a strike based on policies and ideologies advocated by political parties or their student organizations. Participants in such a strike shall be dealt with by the disciplinary authority and will be subjected to appropriate punishment as per the rules.
- No student of the college shall stage or engage in activities such as Dharna, Gherao, or obstructing entry to or from any classroom, office, or other places on campus. Such actions shall be treated as misconduct.
- No student shall shout slogans inside classrooms, offices, or any other place on the college campus, nor shall they obstruct, interfere with, or cause disturbance to the ordinary functioning of the institution. These activities shall be treated as misconduct.

PUNISHMENT FOR MISCONDUCT:

Disciplinary action will be taken against students who commit misconduct as referred to in the above rules, after a due inquiry conducted by a committee appointed by the College Council, if necessary.

The punishment may include:

- (1) Fine
- (2) Issuance of compulsory Transfer Certificate (T.C.)
- (3) Dismissal from the college

In the event of the imposition of dismissal or compulsory issuance of a T.C., the case will be reported to the University.

SAFETY OF COLLEGE PROPERTY

Students shall not disfigure or deface classrooms, walls, or other buildings on the college campus by pasting posters or writing on walls in connection with any activity. They shall not damage or destroy any furniture, equipment, or other materials on campus. If any student is found indulging in such activities, a fine shall be imposed by the Principal based on the extent and magnitude of the damage caused. The fine shall be recovered as arrears of land revenue. In case of non-payment, recovery proceedings shall be initiated against the responsible student(s).

PROHIBITION OF RAGGING

Ragging is strictly prohibited both inside and outside the college campus as per the Ragging Prohibition Act, 1998. Ragging includes any physical or mental torture or disorderly conduct towards any student of the college, causing apprehension, dread, humiliation, or agitation. It includes harassment such as insulting, teasing, or manhandling, or forcing someone to do something they would not normally do voluntarily.

ADMISSION AND WITHDRAWAL

- Students are admitted at the beginning of the academic year to Undergraduate and Postgraduate courses.
- Applications for admission must be made in the prescribed form, which can be downloaded from the college website: www.amv.ac.in
- Applicants for admission to the first-year degree class must have passed the 10+2 examination of the Board or any other recognized equivalent examination. Applicants for admission to Postgraduate courses must have passed the Undergraduate Degree examination in the concerned subject with the required minimum percentage of marks from the affiliating University or any other recognized University

as regular students. Students from universities other than the affiliating university will be admitted as per the admission criteria and availability of seats.

- Candidates seeking admission must produce Transfer and Character Certificates from the school or college last attended, along with qualifying certificates and mark lists, all in original at the time of admission.
- Candidates seeking admission from other universities must apply for recognition and enrolment from Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University.
- Admission is provisional and subject to confirmation after scrutiny of the certificates and enrolment by the University.
- Candidates selected for admission will have to pay the required tuition fees, caution deposit, and other prescribed fees at the time of admission. Fees once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- Any candidate found to have obtained admission through false representation shall be summarily dismissed and shall forfeit any fees paid.
- Students belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, and Other Backward Classes, as evidenced by a valid caste certificate, are exempted from paying tuition fees. Students from Other Backward Classes and converts from other regions must produce a community and income certificate from the regional Tahsildar at the time of admission; otherwise, they will not be exempted from tuition fees.
- Transfer Certificates will not be issued unless the student pays all fees and dues as deemed fit by the Principal. Transfer Certificates are usually not issued before the completion of the course.
- A late fee of Rs. 25 per year will be charged if a student applies for a T.C. one year after the end of the academic session in which they were last enrolled. A fee of Rs. 100/- will be charged for the issue of a duplicate Transfer Certificate.
- Students are not eligible to receive the original T.C. more than once. However, a duplicate T.C. will be issued upon submission of an affidavit signed by a First-Class Judicial Magistrate.
- A student applying for the issue of any document from the college must have cleared all outstanding dues.
- A fee of Rs. 100/- will be charged for issuing documents related to office records older than five years.

TERM AND ATTENDANCE CERTIFICATE

- Academic Calendar is to be published by Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Amravati
- Absence for more than 10 consecutive days without a proper reason will result in the removal of the student's name from the rolls.
- Promotion to higher classes and eligibility to appear for University Examinations shall be subject to the following conditions:
 - a) The student must have earned at least 75% of the attendance prescribed by the College for the course during the semester/year
 - b) He/She must have completed the course of instruction to the satisfaction of the college authorities, and his/her progress, conduct, and character must be satisfactory
- No concession of attendance will be allowed to Student Council Office Bearers and Committee Members for organizing extra-curricular activities.

LIBRARY AND READING ROOM

The college has a centralized library with a full-time librarian and supporting staff. The library is open to students on all working days from 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM. It includes a central section, a reference section, reading room, and a section for periodicals.

LIBRARY RULES

- The library and the reading room will be open from 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM on all working days.
- Books from the general library will be issued on all working days between 8:00 AM and 3:00 PM.
- Applications for books must be made in writing using the prescribed forms.
- Students must examine the books issued to them and report any damage to the Librarian before taking them away.
- Books issued must be returned within fifteen days from the date of issue.
- Students failing to return books by the due date shall pay a fine of Rs. 1 per book per day.
- Strict silence must be observed in the reading room.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION COUNCIL

The College Physical Education Council is constituted with the Principal as the President. A nominated member of the staff will serve as the Vice President, and the Head of the Department of Physical Education will be the Secretary. The President, Vice President, Secretary, and Captains of various sports clubs shall be members of the Executive Committee of the Council. There shall be separate clubs for the following sports:

- Track and

- Field Events

The **captain** of each club will be elected by its members. The Head of the Department of Physical Education will conduct the election. Students of the college are strictly forbidden to enroll in any team outside the college without written permission from the Principal. Students are required to participate in games regularly and undergo regular physical training.

NATIONAL CADET CORPS

Objectives:

- To develop character, commandership, the ideal of service and capacity for leadership in students.
- To provide service training to students to stimulate interest in the defense of our Nation.
- To build up a reserve of potential manpower to enable the armed forces to expand rapidly in a national emergency.

There is an NCC unit with a strength of 92 cadets attached to the college, and enrollment is optional. The training is conducted over a period of two academic years. In the second year of training, every cadet must attend one training camp of 12 days. The cadets are expected to abide strictly by the rules and regulations of the National Cadet Corps. Cadets with a creditable record of attendance and achievements are granted special incentives and benefits by the University in the form of incentive marks and credits for admission to various degree and professional courses. Cadets are also given preference in selection to various posts in the Indian Army, Navy, and Air Force. 'C' certificate holders are eligible for permanent commission into the Indian Military Academy, Dehradun.

NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME

The National Service Scheme provides opportunities for students to participate in community work. The college has two units of the National Service Scheme, each comprising one hundred volunteers.

Aim: To develop personality of the students through Community Service.

Objectives:

1. To work with and among the common people.
2. To enhance creative and constructive social action.
3. To enable students to understand the basic needs of the community.
4. To enable them to achieve self-employment.
5. To develop leadership qualities.
6. To bridge the gap between the educated and the uneducated masses.
7. To promote in students the will to serve the weaker sections of society.

Enrollment in N.S.S. is optional for all students of degree classes. An N.S.S. volunteer who completes 240 hours of regular social service and attends one annual training camp will be issued a certificate by the University. This certificate holder will receive incentive marks for admission to higher studies.

THE COLLEGE MAGAZINE

The college magazine, SHABDARK, is published once a year in the last week of April. It is issued to all students and staff members. Students are encouraged to make the most of this opportunity. Contributions in the form of articles, poems, essays, etc., should be submitted to Dr. A. S. Fulzele, Mr. D. S. Dharane, Dr. H. W. Gedam, Dr. S. M. Sindhi, members of the College Magazine Committee, before 15th December 2026. The magazine will be published only if high-quality content is received by the office before the stipulated date.

PARENT-TEACHER ASSOCIATION:

With a view to develop constructive communication between the guardians of students and teachers of the college, a Parent Teacher Association has been formed. It is expected that such an association will act as a proper forum for guardians and teachers to build strong relations

The association can also significantly contribute to the all-round development of the college by starting new courses of study, instituting endowments, scholarships, prizes, medals, etc., for deserving students. The basic fund of the PTA will be the annual membership fee collected from college students

COLLEGE CANTEEN

A college canteen functions on the campus. Refreshments are available in the canteen to students and staff at concessional rates.

HEALTH CLUB

A Health Club is actively functioning in the college under the guidance of the Director of Physical Education, who serves as its convener. The club plays a vital role in promoting physical fitness, mental well-being, and a healthy lifestyle among both students and staff.

It offers various facilities, including a gymnasium, yoga sessions, meditation practices, and awareness programs on nutrition and overall wellness. Regular fitness activities conducted by the club help reduce stress, improve concentration, and enhance overall productivity.

Additionally, the Health Club organizes health check-up camps, expert lectures, and workshops on hygiene and mental health for faculty and students. It significantly contributes to the holistic development of students and ensures a balanced and active lifestyle throughout their academic journey.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Various scholarships and financial assistance are available to deserving students. Some of them include the National Merit Scholarship, National Loan Scholarship, etc. Fee concession is available to students whose yearly income is less than Rs. 1,00,000/-, and financial assistance is provided to students from Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe categories. Students are instructed to submit online scholarship forms for various scholarships and submit hard copies of the forms to the college office within two weeks of successful online submission, failing which they will be held responsible for the consequences.

ACADEMIC COMMITTEE

An Academic Committee, nominated by the College Council, advises the Principal in streamlining and monitoring academic activities. At the beginning of the academic year, the committee prepares an academic plan for the entire year. Periodic review meetings with departments help monitor the progress. The committee supervises the conduct of terminal examinations, class tests, and other student-centric activities such as seminars, group discussions, debates, elocution, etc.

CAREER GUIDANCE & PLACEMENT CELL

The Career Guidance & Placement Cell functions in the college to provide opportunities for the all-round development of each student's personality. Students graduating from the college receive quality education to advance their careers, leading to excellent placements through the Cell. The main objective of the Cell is to prepare students for challenging careers. It also aims to develop a holistic personality in students, enabling them to succeed and find fulfillment in their personal lives. The ultimate aim is to prepare students to be responsible and responsive to the demands of society.

STUDENTS GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL CELL

A senior faculty member, nominated by the Council, oversees the functioning of the cell. Problems such as harassment and discrimination are addressed by the cell. Students can approach the cell to seek solutions for individual problems. A counseling center also functions under the auspices of the cell. Complaints regarding internal assessments are handled by grievance redressal cells functioning under the Heads of Departments. If the student is not satisfied, he/she may approach the college-level cell functioning under the Principal, Heads of Departments, and Council representatives.

ANTI-RAGGING CELL

This cell functions under strict government guidelines and maintains good liaison with government counterparts to eliminate ragging from the campus. The cell is composed of the Principal as Chairman, a senior HOD as convener, a senior lady teacher(member), a management representative, and a PTA representative.

WOMEN'S GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL CELL

Being a co-educational college, this cell gives special attention to girl students by listening to their problems. The objective of the cell is to address gender issues positively by adopting confidence-building measures to help girl students maintain equality with boys. The cell discusses and resolves issues related to gender harassment.

ETHICS COMMITTEE

The Ethics Committee is constituted to preserve moral values among students and to curb the misuse of mobile phones on campus. The committee monitors students to prevent their involvement in unlawful activities and helps them maintain moral uprightness and a positive demeanor both on and off campus.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

1. Students must respect the institution and adhere to all its rules and regulations.
2. Students must always carry their identity cards and produce them when requested by faculty or staff members.
3. Entry into the college campus is not permitted without the prescribed college uniform.
4. Disruptions in the classroom, including the use of electronic devices, must be avoided as they interfere with the learning process.
5. Students are expected to maintain a clean, safe, and healthy environment and report any safety concerns immediately.
6. All laboratory and equipment protocols must be strictly followed to ensure safety.
7. Academic honesty must be upheld at all times. Plagiarism and the submission of non-original work are strictly prohibited.
8. The use, possession, or distribution of alcohol, drugs, cigarettes, gutkha, or any other controlled substances is strictly prohibited on campus.
9. Any tampering with or disfiguring of the identity card will be taken seriously and dealt with accordingly.
10. Students are not allowed to bring outsiders onto the college premises.
11. Regular attendance and punctuality are mandatory.
12. Cheating or any form of malpractice during examinations is strictly prohibited.
13. Students must leave the campus immediately after their scheduled classes are over for the day.
14. Duplicate identity cards will be issued only upon payment of Rs. 100/- at the designated fee counter.
15. Consistent attendance and punctuality are essential for academic success. Excessive absenteeism and tardiness will not be tolerated.
16. All fees must be paid before the notified deadline. Failure to do so will result in the student being removed from the college roll without further notice.
17. Students must not engage in political activities or assist others in conducting such activities within the campus. All political activities are strictly banned on college premises.
18. Participation in or organization of political gatherings within the campus will be considered a serious act of indiscipline. The Principal is empowered to take disciplinary action against students involved in such activities.
19. Calling for strikes or protests based on political ideologies or party agendas constitutes gross indiscipline. Students participating in such activities will face disciplinary action as per institutional rules.
20. Students must not engage in activities such as dharna, gherao, or obstructing access to classrooms, offices, or other areas of the campus. Such acts will be treated as misconduct.
21. Slogan-shouting or causing disturbances in classrooms, offices, or any part of the campus will be considered misconduct and dealt with seriously.
22. Disciplinary action will be taken against students involved in misconduct after due inquiry by a committee appointed by the Principal.

23. Students must not deface college property, paste posters, or write on walls. Damage to college infrastructure, including furniture and equipment, will lead to a fine determined by the Principal based on the extent of the damage.
24. Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited both inside and outside the campus, in accordance with the Ragging Prohibition Act, 1998. Ragging includes any form of physical or mental harassment, teasing, manhandling, or coercing a student into doing something against their will. Offenders will face strict legal and disciplinary action.

15. Collaborate with peers and administrators to implement effective teaching and institutional practices.
16. Support students in realizing their full potential, while accommodating different learning needs and styles.
17. Lead by example, displaying responsibility, professionalism, and commitment in all interactions.
18. All members of the educational community must abide by these codes of conduct, along with any additional policies set forth by the institution.
